

REGULAR MEETING

March 24th, 2020

Mayor Taylor called the regular meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

New Business:

Kaycee Health Forum Request: The Council was presented with a 1% request from the Kaycee Heath Forum. They will review the request further during budget time.

Street Closure Request: The Council was presented with a request from the Chris LeDoux Memorial Foundation to close a portion of Nolan Avenue for Chris LeDoux Days on June 12-14th. There being no public comment, Councilwoman Davis moved to approve the request as presented. Councilwoman Allen seconded. Motion carried.

Debbie Winters: Ms. Winters asked the Council if the Town of Kaycee could provide community service for her son. The Town does not currently supervise community service. Mayor Taylor will be in contact with Ms. Winters with more information.

Public Hearings: It was suggested that with the current health closures in place, all public hearings including the upcoming liquor license hearing should be postponed at this time. It was agreed to wait until the closures are lifted to proceed with any public hearings.
