NEW BUSINESS:

Lead Service Line Inventory Project Update: Councilman Knapp updated the Council regarding the last meeting with Engineering Associates. The SRF loan requirements currently do not match the requirements of the EPA. The state is working through the best way for municipalities to remain in compliance while completing the project.

Bank Signers: Councilman Knapp moved to remove Mayor Gehrig from all accounts effective June 30th and to add Councilman Foster to all accounts effective June 30th. Councilman Foster seconded. Motion carried.

Proposed Billboard: The Council was presented with a new billboard wrap design from the JCTA. Councilman Knapp moved to accept the design as presented. Councilman Foster seconded. Motion carried.

- The Council discussed a request from a local business to water during the hours of 10-6 due to current operating hours for their business. The Council agreed that the restrictions need to remain as stated.
