PUBLIC HEARING

NEW BUSINESS:

3rd and Final Reading Ordinance 2026.01: Ordinance 2026.01 is an ordinance for the FYE 2027 Budget. Councilman Knapp moved to approve Ordinance 2026.01 as presented. Councilman Foster seconded. Motion carried.

Street Closure Request: The Council was presented with a request from Taylor's Invasion Bar to close a portion of Nolan Avenue on July 11th, for the wiener dog races. Councilwoman Anderson moved to approve the closure as presented. Councilman Foster seconded. Motion carried.

Daughter's of the American Revolution Proclamation: Mayor Gehrig read the proclamation recognizing the Semiquincentennial anniversary on July 4th.
